

Stray Over

Rules and regulations



General

All participants must abide by these rules and any instructions or regulations displayed or given on the day of the event by Battersea Dogs & Cats Home staff, security and volunteers.

1. Entries or substitute entries cannot be accepted on the day to help ensure that the event is safe. We have an allocated capacity that the team must adhere to and the contact details for all participants must be held in advance in the case of an emergency.
2. All participants and volunteers agree that they are happy for their names and any video footage, stills or photographs taken during the event to be used to publicise Stray Over for commercial and fundraising purposes including, but not limited to, television broadcasts, advertising, publications, marketing material, personalised direct mail and other documents that may be made available to the public.
3. All participants must provide the name and number of a person to contact in case of an emergency and details of anything that should be considered in the event of a medical emergency (such as medication being taken) in advance of the event.
4. In the case of an emergency, Battersea Dogs & Cats Home may use the emergency contact details you provided to us.
5. Any participant unsure of their physical ability to take part in an event should take medical advice from a General Practitioner prior to the event. Those with asthma, epilepsy, diabetes, a heart condition or any other medical condition which may be restrictive to their participation in this event should consult their General Practitioner prior to signing up for the challenge. Pregnant women are also advised to consult their GP prior to signing up. You are strongly advised not to participate if you are or have recently been suffering from a cold or flu symptoms.
6. All participants enter the Stray Over entirely at their own risk. Battersea Dogs & Cats Home shall not be liable for any injury, damage or loss howsoever suffered by participants as a result of their participation other than in respect of death or personal injury arising as a result of Battersea Dogs & Cats Home's negligence.
7. Battersea Dogs & Cats Home takes all reasonable

steps to minimise the risk of injury to participants during this event. There is a stringent risk assessment process in place that aims to minimise or eliminate the risk to everyone taking part. However, by taking part in the Stray Over, you acknowledge that there may be conditions or circumstances beyond our control that can lead to unforeseen risks. If you have any concerns or queries please contact us before agreeing to take part in the event.

Entry rules for Stray Over

1. Please note that participants must be at least 18 years old on the day of the event to take part.
2. This event is open to corporate and business teams only. Unfortunately, we cannot accept entries from non corporate teams.
3. We ask that each team raises a minimum of £2,500 in sponsorship for the Home. Any monies raised in connection with Stray Over is held on trust for Battersea Dogs & Cats Home and must be passed to Battersea Dogs & Cats Home. We ask that you do this as soon as practicable after the event.
4. You can:

 - If opting for the company funded sponsorship you can request that we invoice you by emailing strayover@battersea.org.uk
5. You have a legal responsibility to ensure that all sponsorship monies/donations received by you for Stray Over are paid to Battersea Dogs & Cats Home. Please ensure that all sponsorship forms are returned to us to enable us to claim Gift Aid where possible.
6. All participants must abide by any rules, instructions and regulations displayed or given on the day of the event by Battersea Dogs & Cats Home staff, security and volunteers.

On the night

1. Battersea Dogs & Cats Home asks that participants only smoke within the designated smoking area for the event. The location of this will be communicated to you on the evening.
2. Battersea Dogs & Cats Home asks that all participants do not use aggressive or abusive language or behaviour towards our organisers and volunteers.
3. No alcohol must be brought by participants onto the premises. Alcohol will be provided for the evening by the organisers and we reserve the right to confiscate any found to be brought in from the outside.
4. No animals belonging to the team or participants must be brought to the event.
5. First aid facilities will be provided at the event. Participants consent to their details (which will be obtained by medical providers if participants are treated by them at an event) being passed to Battersea Dogs & Cats Home. Battersea Dogs & Cats shall only use these details for administration and health and safety purposes and to fulfil its legal obligations, including those under the Reporting of Injuries, Diseases and Dangerous Occurrences Regulations 1995. All medical details will be securely held by Battersea Dogs & Cats Home. The information will be handled in accordance with the terms of the Data Protection Act 1998.
6. Battersea Dogs & Cats Home reserves the right to remove any person from the event and premises should they break the rules or be considered a danger to other participants.

Filming and photography at the event

1. By taking part, all participants and volunteers agree that they are happy for their names and any video footage, stills or photographs taken during the events to be used by Battersea Dogs & Cats Home (and our authorised service providers and agents) for commercial and/or fundraising purposes including but not limited to television broadcasts, advertising, publications, marketing material, merchandising, personalised direct mail and other documents that may be made available to the public.
2. Battersea Dogs & Cats Home may appoint third party photographers to take photographs at the event. All participants agree that their photographs may be sent to them and to other people featured in their photographs.

Battersea Dogs & Cats Home will use the information you have provided to contact you with fundraising tips as well as information about Stray Over.

It is vital for the dogs and cats in our care that we can communicate with our supporters. Battersea Dogs & Cats Home and Battersea Dogs & Cats Home Ltd would like to keep you up to date about the work we are doing, to tell you about the amazing difference you have made and how your financial support can help more animals. We will only do this if you tell us that you are happy for us to contact you for this purpose, and have supplied your postal address, telephone number, mobile number or email for us to do so. You do not have to provide this information for marketing purposes and you can remove or change any of these preferences at any time.

We respect your right of privacy and to have your data kept securely. We may use your data for profiling, targeting and research purposes. We will never exchange, sell or rent your data.
